## About

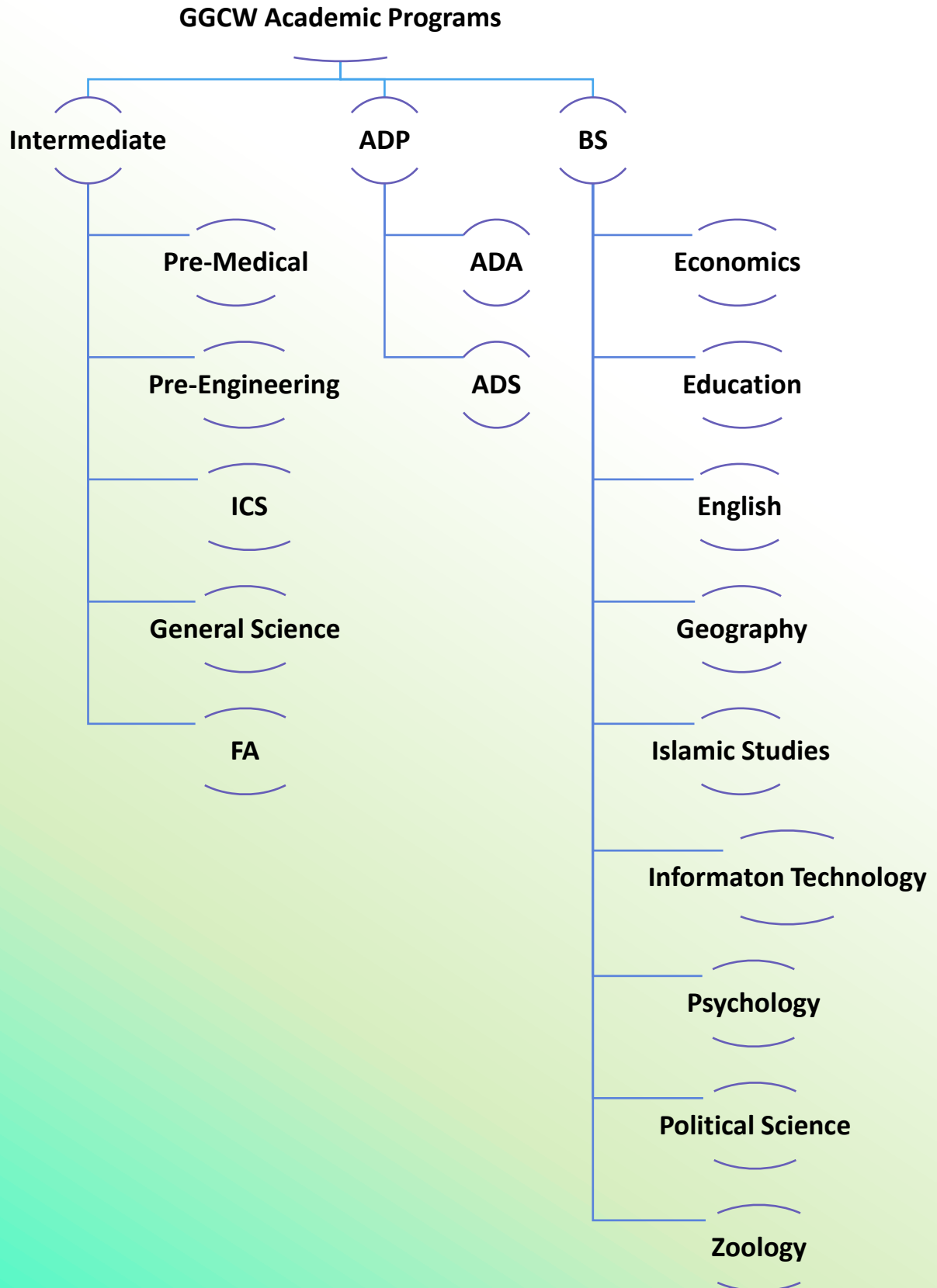

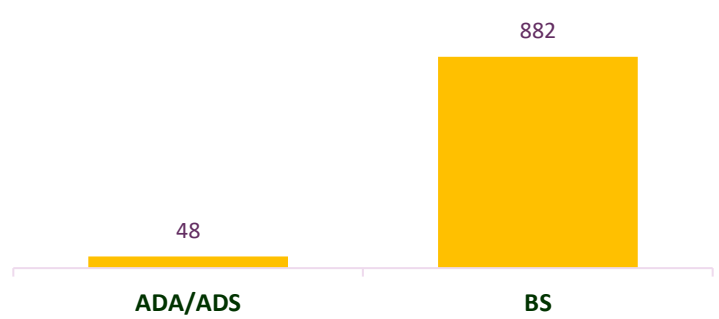
### Total Enrollment



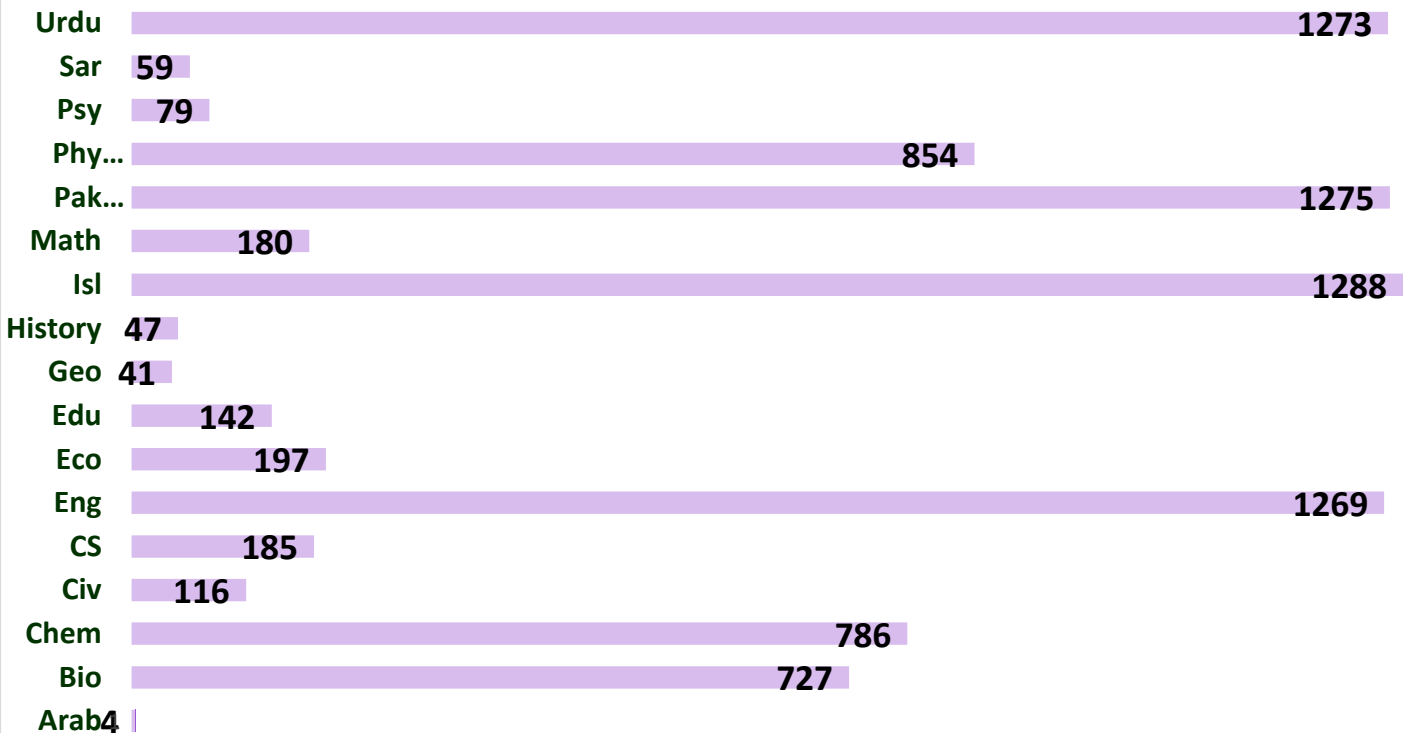

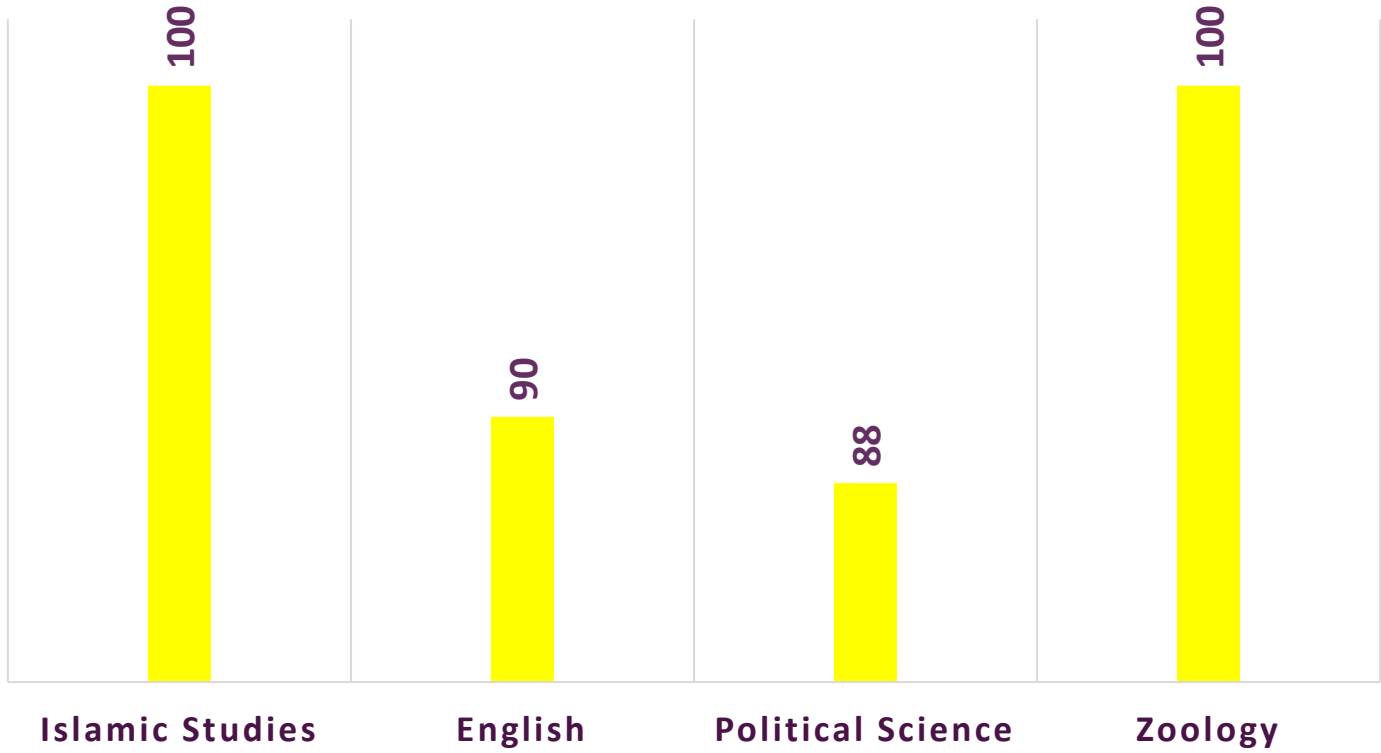

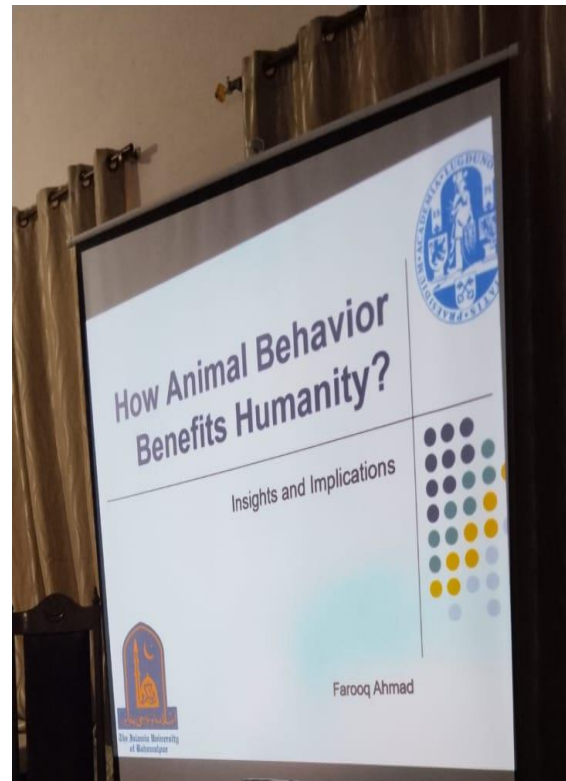


## Seminar: Animal Behavior

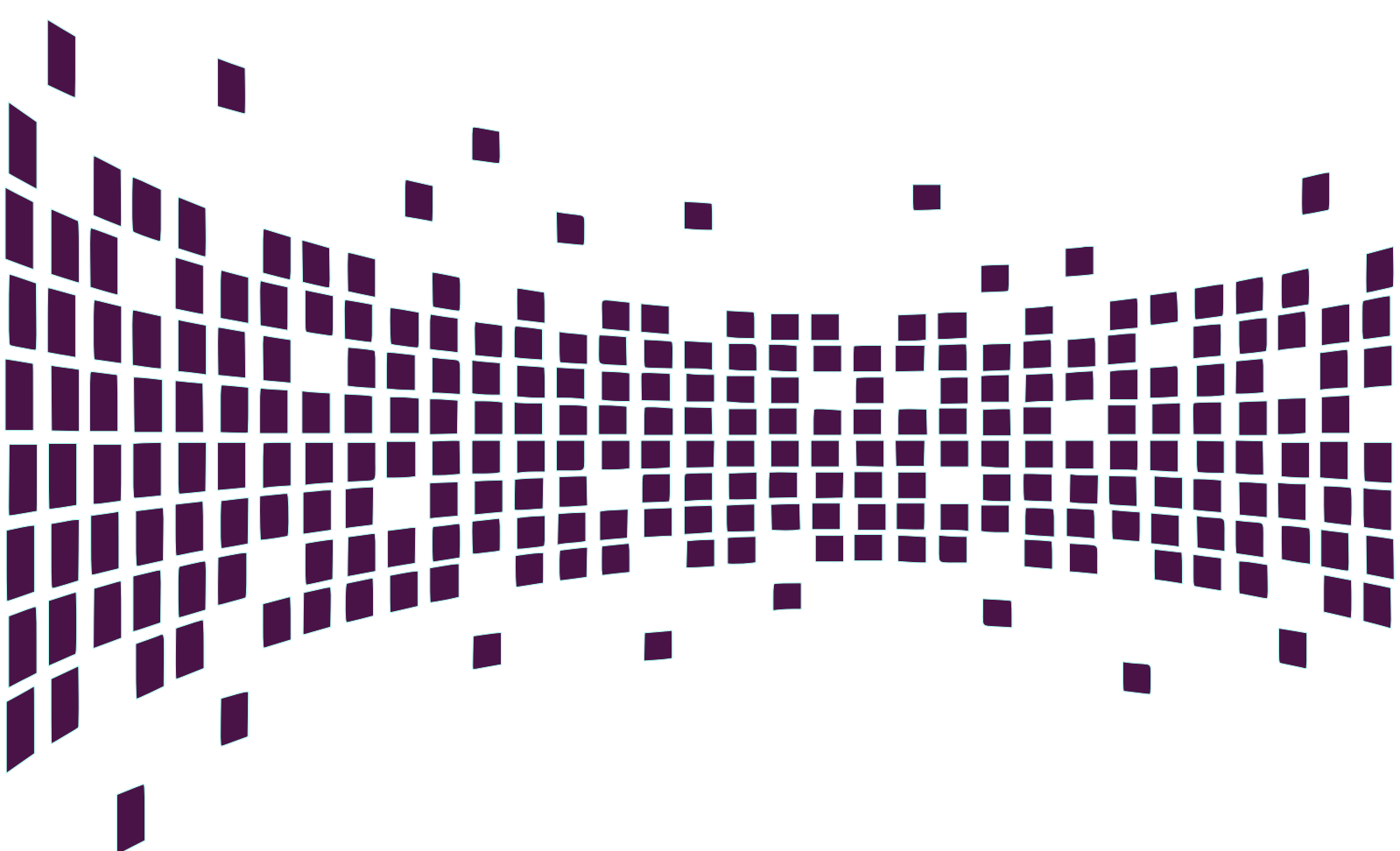

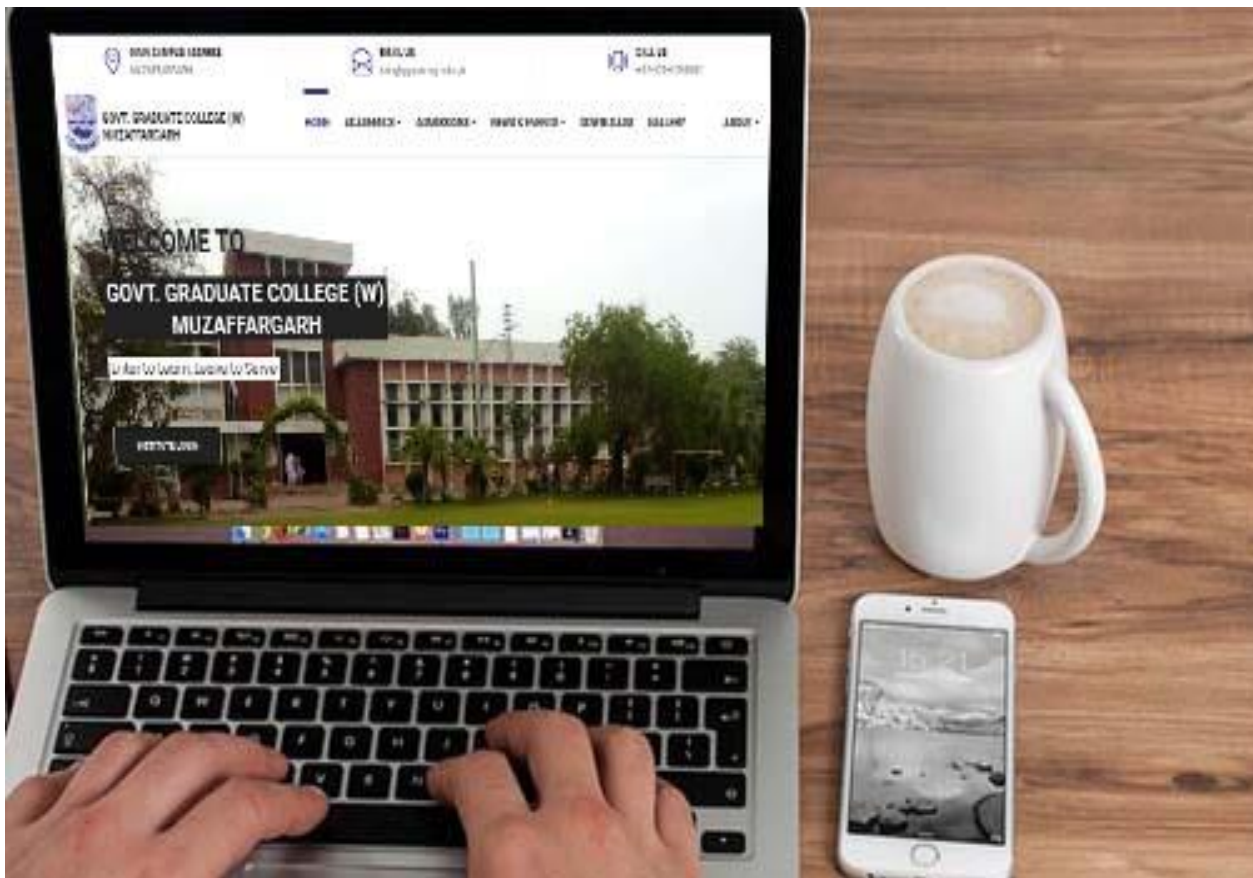
